CON EDISON, NYPA UNITS APPROVE CBAs, CONTRACTS APPROVED BY WIDE MARGINS

Local 1-2 President James T. Slevin announced that Members at both the Con Edison Bargaining Unit and the New York Power Authority Bargaining Unit had overwhelmingly approved their new Contracts.

The Membership approved both Contracts by percentages of 90% in each Bargaining Unit.

Both agreements will remain in effect into 2020.

"On behalf of the Officers and the Executive Board of Local 1-2, we thank all of our Brothers and Sisters for standing together and approving these Contracts," Slevin said.

"For our Brothers and Sisters at NYPA, they waited for seven years to get a fair and decent shake. NYPA shuffled its deck so many times they made it impossible to sit down and hammer out an agreement. Patience was tested beyond endurance and it was only by making noise in Albany that they came around," Slevin added.

Slevin said " I am happy that bring back a contract to the members that work in the Con Ed bargaining unit. This contract could not have been possible without the strong Unity and Solidarity that I saw from the membership and it will improve their lives for years to come."

"Without the Strike Authorization from the Membership, Con Ed was looking to gut the Union anyway it could and move it back to the 19th Century. The power of No and our ability to Strike were our weapons and we used them," Slevin said.
