**LOCAL 1-2, NY, UTILITY WORKERS UNION OF

REACHES TENTATIVE AGREEMENT WITH
ENTERGY OVER INDIAN POINT,
CONTRACT WILL RUN THROUGH 2022**

Local 1-2 President James T. Slevin said Wednesday, January 24, 2018 that the Union had reached a tentative agreement shortly after 2 a.m. with Entergy for a Collective Bargaining Agreement to run to 2022 for its Members at the Indian Point nuclear energy facility in Buchanan, NY.

Slevin said. **“It has been a grueling pace for more than a week of around the clock talks with Entergy to come to a tentative agreement for our Members who work at Indian Point. The details of the agreement must now be brought to our Indian Point Members for a ratification vote. We believe it is a contract that we can present to the Members that will take them to 2022.**

“There were times during the past two weeks when the outlook was bleak, and the Union was on the verge of invoking its strike authorization. Fortunately, we were able to remain at the table. Thanks to the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service for their efforts during this tough fight.”
